- Promote and maintain safety practices throughout the organization, involving all personnel to ensure a safe working environment.;
- Comply with all relevant Work Health and Safety, contractual and industry related legislative requirements;
- Maintain and review measurable objectives and targets to ensure continual improvement towards the prevention and reduction of work-related injury and illness;
- Ensure appropriate emergency procedures exist in all work locations and that personnel understand the
 procedures relevant to their location and the greater work area;
- Continuously improve the working environment by consulting and communicating lessons learned;
- Provide appropriate induction, training, instruction and supervision ;
- All workers shall be physically and psychologically fit for work, including when travelling to and from work;
- The work environment is free from drugs and alcohol for all Workers;
- Provide Workers with the right to stop work on any task if they believe is unsafe;
- All accidents/incidents shall be reported and appropriately investigated; and
- Provide appropriate protective equipment to meet the relevant needs of each area of work activity.

The key responsibilities relating to MCS Work Health and Safety Policy include:

- The development and implementation of this policy rests with the executive team of MCS; and
- Commitment to this policy and the elements of the Health and Safety Management System rests with all Workers of MCS.
